Dear Students & Parents/Guardians,

We are pleased to welcome you to the 2020-21 regular school year at WestShore's Langford Campus. You have likely already received information from School District 62 (Sooke) outlining the basic scheduling and structure of the school year for the majority of schools in our district. As you already know, the WestShore Langford Campus does not fit into the model used by our other SD62 high schools and things will look a little bit different at our Campus. Our distributed learning courses are continuing as normal with flexible start dates and students being able to work through courses at a pace that is best for them.

Registration for grade 10-12 courses is currently open to school aged and adult students who live in the local (lower Vancouver Island) area and are able to attend the WestShore Langford Campus in person as required (ie: supervised tests &/or in person support). Students registered with another SD62 school can take individual courses with us while also attending their home school. Full time 10-12 programs are also available for students who are sure they want to move to an entirely online program for 2020-21. New students and current students can add courses to their schedule can do so on the registration page of our website. Students needing help with planning their graduation program can book an appointment with our academic advisor by calling 250-391-9002.

We are accepting registrations from students currently living in the School District 62 catchment area for full time grade 9 programs. Grade 9 students attending another school may register for individual grade 10 courses.

StoreFront (our f2f support classroom) is open for our students during regular school hours. Access to storefront is by appointment only – you can book appointments online via our website www.westshorecentre.com. Students in our alternate education program will be assigned in person class time. Schedules for these students will be communicated during the week of September 8th -11th.
